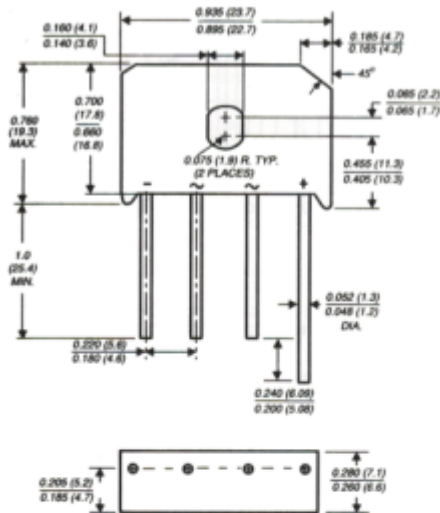

FIG. 1 - DERATING CURVE OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

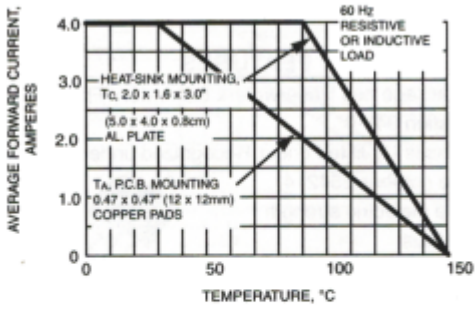


FIG. 2 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG

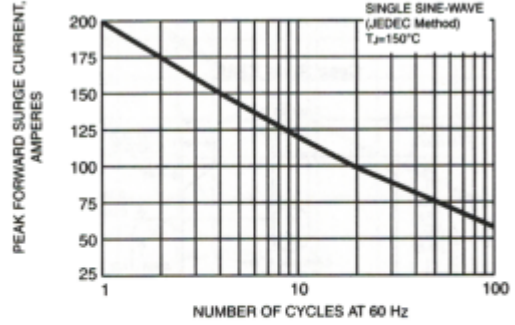


FIG. 3 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG

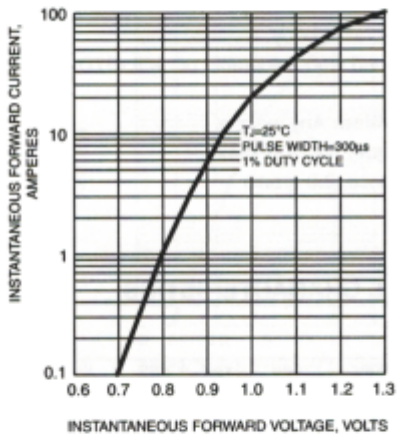


FIG. 4 - TYPICAL REVERSE LEAKAGE CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG

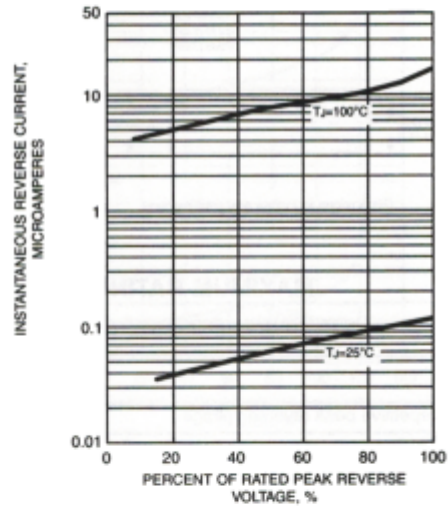


FIG. 5 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE PER LEG
